Changes Coming for Regulation CC Expedited Funds Availability

The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010, commonly referred to as The Dodd-Frank Act, includes a provision to increase the next-day funds availability requirement from \$100 to \$200. The increased funds availability provision will become effective on July 21, 2011.



CUA Keys to Financial Success

Be SMART

Wishful thinking has never made a budget work. Setting a goal for your budget needs to be SMART:

Specific: Smart goals are specific enough to suggest action. Example: Set a goal to save enough to take a family vacation, not just an abstract goal to save money.

Measurable: You need to know when you have achieved your goal, or how close you are. Example: A family vacation will cost around \$1,200, and so far you have saved \$500.

Attainable: The steps towards reaching your goal need to be reasonable and possible. Example: I know that I can save \$50 from each paycheck to put towards a family vacation.

Relevant: The goal needs to make sense. You don't want to work toward a goal that doesn't fit your need. Example: Trying to stay at four star hotels for your family vacation.

Time-related: Set a definite target date. Example: I would like to plan this vacation for next summer.
